1. Executive Summary:

This year we have increased our efforts to strengthen the presence of our Chair and the collaboration networks around the world.

We have consolidated our operating structure thanks to our University and the support received to finance a research grant during all these years. We have also continued to improve our website https://www.comunesco.com/ as an instrument of knowledge transfer, we have actively participated in International Congresses, and we have also organized special academic seminars.

In the events we have organized, we have paid special attention to the future of journalism and the situation of human rights and communication processes. Similarly, we have attended congresses organized by national and international Communication Associations, specifically 7 of them organized by AE-IC (Spanish Association for Communication Research) and 2 by ALAIC (Latin American Association of Communication Researchers).

At the same time, we have published materials in national and international magazines as a way of establishing ourselves as a reference in Communication Studies. Of these materials, we have published 4 articles indexed in JCR Q2, 1 article in JCR Q1, 2 articles in SCOPUS Q2 and 2 in Emerging Science Citation Index ESCI.
