1. Summary

In 2022, the presence of our Chair and collaborative networks in Spain and around the world has been consolidated. The mission of the UNESCO Chair in Communication Research is linked to the main objectives of UNESCO, as well as those set out in the 2030 Agenda.

This Chair is directly linked to one of the main declarations and mission of UNESCO, the promotion of intercultural dialogue through education, science, culture, communication, and information.

We have organized different academic activities, with the participation of undergraduate and postgraduate students. The speakers, specialists from different latitudes and disciplines, have offered keynote lectures on topics such as negotiation strategies in the audiovisual industry, cultural representations and gender perspectives in contemporary cinema, the principles of intercultural communication, motherhood, and patriarchy in post-apocalyptic cinema, among others.

As part of our priority efforts, the dissemination of our projects is continuously carried out on our website https://www.comunesco.com/. A mechanism that functions as a tool for knowledge transfer, in which information is actively shared about participations in international conferences, as well as in our own activities such as specialized academic seminars.

Also, we have had several guest professors as researchers, both national and international, developing different cooperation activities with the Chair office this year.

Considering our priorities in knowledge transfer, we have published scientific material in national and international journals, seeking to establish ourselves as a reference in the field of Communication. Of this material, the total inventory produced is as follows: **2 books**, **4 book chapters and 9 journal articles**.

e) Cooperation with UNESCO Headquarters

Cooperation with the organization of the ORBICOM 2022 International Congress and Meeting "Public Communication for Social Justice, Human Rights and Territorial Development in the Digital Age", which was held from 9 to 11 November 2022.

Considering the implications of the global health crisis, which meant an unforeseen challenge in crisis communication policies, and which once again placed the State at the center of public communication, the Annual Meeting and International Congress of the Network of UNESCO Chairs in Communication Orbicom, organized by the National University of Villa María and an international Latin American network, was held in order to promote public communication as a human right, intangible heritage, social capital, space for the construction of identities and cultures.

In line with the objectives of the project presented and evaluated, the following is expected:

- Reflections in debate that promote awareness of the need to develop public communication in the new socio-digital environments with social justice.
- Academic discussions that raise awareness of human rights and the rights of audiences, consumers, actors, and subjects. As well as the public, legal, ethical, cultural, and human responsibilities of those who manage media, generate and/or circulate messages.
- The congress seeks to promote territorial development by visualizing the strategic importance of communication as a dimension that constructs meanings about the very concept of development, its consensuses, its possibilities, its debates, among others, in the digital era. 3. Future plans and development prospects:

The Unesco Chair in Communication Research, promoted by the Rey Juan Carlos University, focuses its activities in the field of high-level research and communication studies. This strategic option aims to foster research in communication studies, together with the improvement of the development process through the promotion of communication, freedom of expression, etc.

Our overall objective includes:

- 1. Creating a space for reflection and research on social and communication issues related to global interests and priorities.
- 2. To sponsor research stays, both of our members in other institutions, and vice versa, inviting professors to collaborate with our Chair.
- 3. Establish a strategic partnership between the Chair and other institutions to help develop specific agreements with foreign universities.

Our specific objectives are:

- 1. Enhance and internationalise a postgraduate and Master's programme that includes at least 20% of students/researchers from developing countries.
- 2. Organise permanent research seminars on communication issues. These seminars will feature keynote speakers, including experts in communication and social issues.
- 3. Develop editorial and communication instruments for the dissemination of the Chair's activities and exchange of experiences with international and national researchers.
- 4. Publication of a book by the Chair annually and promotion of a specialised issue in an indexed journal.
